

# **Diving Medical Examination**

## **\*Instructions for Student\***

Attached you'll find copies of the Diving Medical Examination necessary to have completed in order to be accepted and attend the Minnesota Commercial Diver Training Center, Inc. (aka MCDTC).

It's essential that you get your Diving Medical Examination done as soon as possible, and if possible please see a physician whose name appears on the list of doctors who're members of the Undersea & Hyperbaric Medical Society (aka UHMS). You'll find this list at <http://membership.uhms.org/?page=DME>. Please note that you may choose to see your regular physician, and we will forward your results to a UHMS physician for final approval. Your results must meet the most recent minimum standards for commercial diving as recommended by the UHMS.

Please bring the following forms to have completed and signed during your appointment;

1. The *Diving Medical Examination \*Instructions for Physician\**
2. The *Diving Medical Examination Consent Form*
3. The *ADCI Medical History* from (you should fill out pages 1-2 and show to your physician for concurrence) and *Physical Examination Form* (pages 3-4)
4. The *Diving Medical Examination* form (this has a check list of the extra documents such as Chest X-ray(s), Hemoglobin, Urinalysis, ect... that you need to send to us with the rest of these completed forms)
5. The *Medical Acceptance* form

\*Please be truthful with your results to help insure your safety and the safety of other students that'll be in class with you. Students who are found to have falsified their medical information may be withdrawn from MCDTC's program.
